

Outcomes for Students

By the end of the **Common Assessment and Orientation Programme**, most EAL students will be ready to join some or all of the mainstream school curriculum, with the support of class buddies, key workers *i.e. learning mentors, EAL or bilingual teacher assistants* and EAL specialist teachers. Students will be able to identify areas of language and curriculum learning where they need additional support as well as their current strengths, and will also know enough to begin to participate in school activities and understand how and where to get information about:

- how the school and curriculum is organised
- how to get to and from school using the local transport system
- who can help in school - key staff and class buddies
- how their timetable works
