This particular summer's planting scheme is a celebration of life. The flowers are buzzing with butterflies and insects and in the background the park is humming with people enjoying the warmth of the sunshine.

Each plant grows in a small community and takes structural support from its neighbours. It is to this community of plants that the bees flock, building up their reserves of energy to produce another bountiful harvest of Holland Park honey.

The dramatic planting in the sundial beds has been repeated in the centre of the Dutch Garden, which provides a sense of balance and continuity to the overall design. The surrounding white Phlox add both a delightful scent to the garden and a counter point to the riot of colour provided by the Delphiniums, Dahlias and Lobelias.

However, I have also strived to provide the visitor with a sense of calm and serenity – so necessary in our vibrant city. From the side seats you will be able to enjoy both the drama of this planting and the calming scent of Lavender

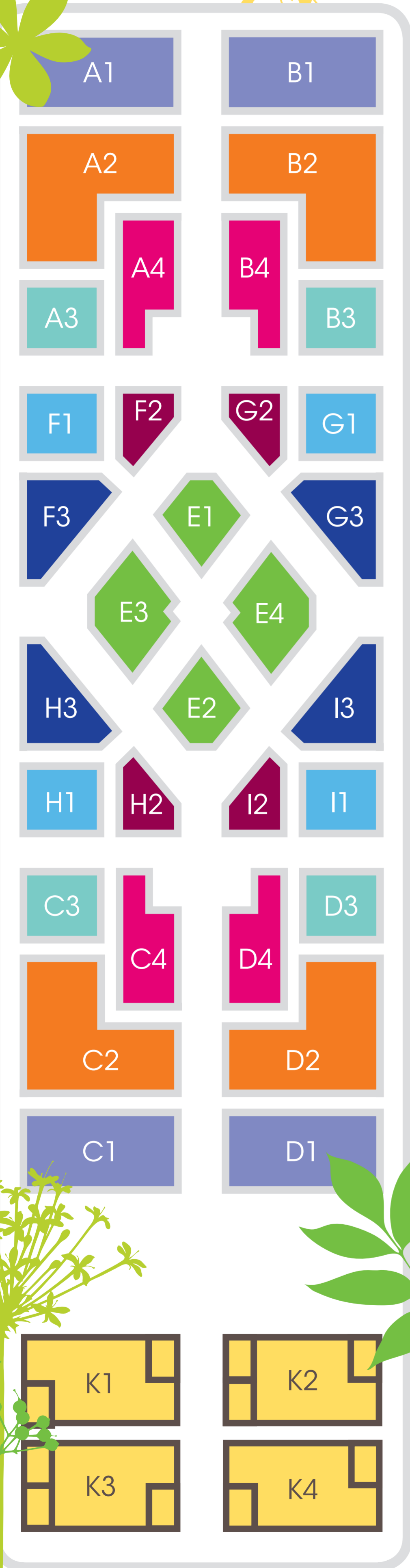
Just a hint of thunder clouds in the evening sky.
