

OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS – WASTE DISPOSAL

1. The Contractor will transport to and deposit all waste, litter, and sweepings at locations determined by the Western Riverside Waste Authority (WRWA), the Council's Waste Disposal Authority.
2. In order to comply with statutory Duty of Care requirements an annual waste transfer note shall be completed by the Contractor outlining the annual amounts of waste that will be delivered to WRWA. This documentation must be countersigned by the Council's Head of Waste Management and the Senior Contracts Manager and forwarded to WRWA before 1 April each year.
3. The Contractor will be provided with details of WRWA's Health and Safety procedures so they can be incorporated into the Contractor's employees' Health and Safety training programme. All contract staff shall comply with WRWA's on-site Health and Safety requirements.
4. The transfer stations normally used for the disposal of waste and recycling material under the Contract will be:
 - Western Riverside, Smugglers Way, Wandsworth, SW18.
 - Cringle Dock, Cringle Street, Battersea, SW8.
5. Diversions may be made between the various transfer stations at the direction of WRWA.
6. The best estimate of normal turnaround times as at 2011 is set out below:

ALTERNATIVE DISPOSAL SITES

The Contractor may from time to time be required to dispose of refuse at transfer stations other than those detailed above, and shall include provision for such events in operational planning throughout the Contract Period. Such alternative transfer stations may be under the control of the Waste Disposal Authority, the Contractor, or a private site operator, and may be around ten miles from the boundary of the Royal Borough. In such circumstances the Contractor shall ensure that waste collection and recycling services continue without undue disruption.
