

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE**  
**DOGS (specified maximum) ORDER 2007**

**NOTIFICATION PURSUANT TO REGULATION 3 OF**  
**THE DOG CONTROL ORDER (PROCEDURES)**  
**REGULATIONS 2006 MADE UNDER**  
**S.56(4) AND S.56(5) OF THE**  
**CLEAN NEIGHBOURHOODS AND ENVIRONMENT ACT 2005**

The Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea propose to amend the Dogs (specified maximum) Order 2007 made on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2007. This order made it an offence for a person in charge of more than one dog to take more than 2 dogs onto land specified in Schedule 1 of the order, at any time. The land specified in Schedule 1 is listed below.

The proposal is to amend the order to make it an offence for a person in charge of more than one dog to take more than 6 dogs onto land specified in Schedule 2 of the above-mentioned order.

It is therefore proposed that The Dogs (specified maximum) order 2007 be amended as follows:

Paragraph 3 is replaced by the following paragraph “On land to which this order applies the maximum number of dogs which a person may take on to that land is six.”

The current Dogs (specified maximum) order 2007 including the area of land covered by the order can be inspected free of charge between the hours of 9.30am – 8pm on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays and 9.30am – 5pm on Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays (library opening hours) at Kensington Central Library, Phillimore Walk, London W8 7RX.
