How do I find out about the Council's planning policies?

You can look on our web site where we publish details of all current consultations that are taking place and where we make available all our agreed policy documents.

Alternatively, you can call in to the Planning Information desk at the Town Hall, or e-mail us at planning@rbkc.gov.uk

You can also purchase hard copies of our Unitary Development Plan, which sets out all our planning policies that are presently in force.

How do I get involved in the preparation of the Council's Local Development Framework?

You can look on our web site where we publish details of all current consultations that are taking place.

You can also call our Planning Policy team on 020 7361 3879 or e-mail them on planningpolicy@rbkc.gov.uk and ask to be included on a database of people who receive mail shots each time there is a consultation exercise.
