Love the streets you trade in

To become a trader with us you must follow the 3 steps below. Once you have traded with us as a casual trader you may apply for a permanent site. Please see overleaf for the current Restricted items list.

Firstly, you must send photos of your goods for approval to:
street.trading@rbkc.gov.uk **Once your commodity/s have been approved by one of the Street Trading Officers, you need to obtain Third Party Public Liability Insurance.**

Your insurance must be up to the value of **£5,000,000**, which is standard and can be obtained from:

Your insurance must show your name and not a company name.

Once you have your insurance, you need to register as a trader at the market office. Registration costs £9.00 and must be done in person at: The



Market Office, 72 Tavistock Road, London W11 1AN.

Registration is possible on Monday-Thursday between 9am and 1pm.

To register, you will need to bring the following:

- Your Third Party Public Liability Insurance certificate.
- Two forms of ID. These must include: UK Passport, Non UK-Passport with work visa, Driving Licence, national ID card and bank statement or utility bill (not mobile phone bill).
- Proof of your National Insurance number, e.g.: National Insurance card or wage slip, P45, P60 etc
- Registration Fee - £9.00 (payable by debit/credit card with PIN, or postal order)

You are now ready to trade! Just turn up on the day you wish to trade (Mon-Thursday at 8am and Fri and Sat at 7am) and you can go through our allocation procedure.

Saturday New goods: £47.00, Second hand: £45*

Arts & Crafts Market (hand made items, including clothing) on Tavistock Piazza (outside market office)

WE ARE HAPPY TO REGISTER TRADERS SELLING:

We have vacancies on our Arts & Crafts market; Hand made arts and crafts, books, stationery, greetings cards and wrapping paper. Good quality ceramics & glassware.

We have limited availability for Bedding, DVDs (certificated and on general release in the UK) and some items of men's clothing. (British Standard Marking) toys.

Second hand items, including clothing, books and retro household goods.

We can register casual traders selling antiques but availability in the antiques section is limited on Saturdays. Friday trading of Antiques is currently available for **£10** per stall per Friday. All goods registered under Antique **MUST** be over 50 years old.

If we do not have vacancies for your goods on Saturday, we may be able to accommodate your goods during the week; Monday– Wednesday and possible Friday.

WE CANNOT REGISTER TRADERS SELLING:



We currently have **no vacancies** in the **new goods** section however we will register casual traders to trade where there are vacancies in other sections. We will not register :

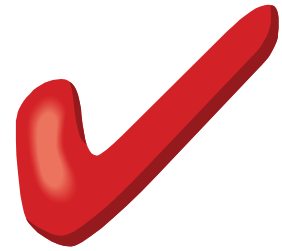
Batteries, Socks, hats, gloves, phone accessories or phone cards, luggage, belts, T-shirts, **ladies clothing**, videos, Watches, Sunglasses, Shoes, new CDs or music tapes, sunglasses, underwear (unless hand made),

watches, souvenirs and **jewellery**.

No Ladies Accessories or Handbags of any kind.

Second hand toys or second hand electrical equipment are not permitted, Knives, except normal kitchen knives, solvents or any kind of real or imitation firearms.

No counterfeit goods or unauthorised copies of copyright designs or labels. Fortune-telling, tattooing, body piercing, head massage, hairdressing or tarot reading.
