Dear Colville Residents,
Welcome to the latest edition of the Colville newsletter.

In the past month Colville ward has been given extra resources, including a mobile police van, to deal with any anti-social behaviour (ASB) on the ward. Officers were tasked with undertaking targeted patrols in the area, which resulted in an increased officer presence. These patrols have ensured we've had a decrease in anti-social behaviour in the area which we will endeavour to continue.

We had some great results from our officers this week including two suspects arrested on Colville ward after they had crashed and initially ran off from a vehicle they had stolen. The victim was informed and his vehicle was restored to him. The suspects are currently on bail. Thankfully no-one was injured during the incident.

Colville Ward Priorities:

Compared to June '13....

- **Burglary** is down by 75%
- **Shoplifting/theft** is down by 53%
- **ASB** a number of arrests have been made in the past month relating to ASB caused by drinkers. Police are working together with the council and local licensed venues with the view to implementing dispersal zone in the area so that we can deal more robustly with ongoing ASB issues relating to local street drinkers. One in three burglaries is committed by opportunist thieves through open windows and doors. Keep your windows shut if you are going out or are in bed.
