Would you like to benefit from 10 per cent and 15 per cent off your next course bookings?

From 1 January 2014, if you book within five days of attending a course, you or your staff will be eligible to fee reductions on further Level Award courses run by the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea's Public Health Training Service.

- A 10 per cent discount will be offered if you book one to two places booked on any Level Award course.

Terms and conditions of the Discount Offer

- This offer only applies once you or your colleagues have attended a course that has been booked and paid for (at the full rate) after 1 January 2014.
- Delivery is dependent on demand, availability of trainers and training rooms at the Council offices, or the suitability of training venues and audio-visual equipment to be supplied by you if courses are to be run in your premises.
- Payment is required at the time of making your booking.
- 10 per cent discount for one to two people, and 15 per cent discount for three to eight people, booked on any further Level courses.
- If you book more than eight places the discount offer does not apply but the ninth person will be able to attend free of charge.
- VAT is not applicable to course fees.
