

Expenses and costs in respect of the work of Councillor D Moylan, Deputy Leader of the Council

Councillor Moylan is responsible as deputy leader for a significant burden of the corporate management of the Authority and also has a decision-making portfolio covering land use planning strategy and the Council's estate strategy for its 7000 public housing units and associated land.

Councillor Moylan is also the Council's appointed *Design Champion*, and chairs the Public Art Advisory Group.

Since October 2008 Councillor Moylan has incurred the following costs, on the Council's corporate purchase card:

Councillor Moylan has taken 14 taxi rides in the last twelve months at a total cost of £325.86. All these trips were within London between appointments. One railway trip to Birmingham cost £163.00. All other journeys were by public transport where no claim was made from the Council.

Councillor Moylan has reason to travel abroad for his private business and has a holiday home overseas. To ensure he can continue with his council duties, the Council meets the cost of sending papers to him by courier. These costs totalled £880.02 in the year October 2008-October 2009.
