# Parking suspensions

Parking suspensions will come into force in this area from **7am to 11pm on Sunday 30 August and Monday 31 August.**

Please make arrangements to park your vehicle at an alternative location during this period.

Over Carnival weekend, holders of Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea resident parking permits may park their cars in a resident bay elsewhere within the borough – but outside of the Carnival area.

The Council offers resident permit holders the facility to park in the Town Hall car park, Hornton Street, at a reduced rate of £6 per day on Saturday 29, Sunday 30 and Monday 31 August 2009. For more information call 020 7937 7040.

The streets where the Carnival suspensions apply will be clearly indicated by yellow suspension warning notices fixed to the posts next to the relevant parking bays. It would greatly assist the police if residents moved their vehicles the night before. Vehicles that are not moved **by 7am** may be removed and repositioned.

To ensure that the clean-up after Carnival runs as smoothly as possible, it would be helpful if residents would delay bringing their vehicles back into the Carnival area until as late as possible – ideally not **until the morning of Tuesday 1 September.**
