

Crèches

Where the organiser of an event wishes to operate Crèche facilities on Council premises:

Under the Children Act part XA Schedule 9A, crèches which operate for less than six days in any year are exempt from registration. However they should notify the registration authority in writing before the first occasion on which the premises are so used. The authority to refer to is:
