1 Background

- 1.1 On 8 November 2023, the Leadership Team received a report from the Executive Director for Resources setting out the Treasury Management Mid-Year Report 2023/24, which it has submitted to Full Council for consideration.
- 1.2 The second item was the Annual Treasury Outturn Report 2022-2023. The Council's Treasury Management Practices require an annual treasury outturn report for the Lead Member for Finance and the Audit and Transparency Committee.
