Dear Miss Nagouri,

I am in receipt of your TEN for Kensington Memorial Park.

I am advised by my colleagues in the Events team and Parks department, that you have not been in dialogue with them on obtaining permission for the event to be held in the park on this date.

I understand the park was used last year for this event, without the appropriate permissions being in place, hence no Risk Assessments and Event Management plans were submitted to the Council, to enable permission to be granted.

One of the Licensing Objectives is Public Safety and without these documents and permission being in place, the public safety key objective is not being promoted.

In view of this, I am now objecting to your TEN for this event, under the public safety key objective. In order for this objection to be withdrawn, you now need to promptly commence Liaison with these Council departments, to obtain permission for the use of the park.

I have copied in Miss Scally, in the special events team, and Miss Castelino in the parks department, who you will now need to contact about your event. Once they are satisfied that the appropriate documentation are being developed or submitted, they will let me know, so I can withdraw my objection.

I also have to make you aware that an objection will automatically trigger a Licensing hearing, where Councillors will adjudicate on the TEN, it usually takes 10 days following the objection and it would be appreciated if you could commence this liaison as a matter of urgency to resolve these issues, such that the hearing wont be required. I am writing in response to your recent objection to our Temporary Event Notice (TEN) for Kensington Memorial Park. Firstly, I would like to clarify that there seems to be a misunderstanding regarding the location of our previous event. We did not hold our event at Kensington Memorial Park last year; rather, it took place at Hornimans Park. Additionally, I would like to emphasise that diligently followed all necessary procedures in obtaining the required permissions and submitting the relevant documentation for our events.

Contrary to the information provided, we were in regular communication with Greg from the special events team and submitted all the necessary documents as per the council's requirements. We have records of our correspondence and can provide evidence of the documents submitted. Furthermore, I can confirm that we applied for licenses for both of our events, and if any documents were missing or incomplete, a license would not have been issued to us.

We understand the importance of public safety, and can assure you that we take this matter very seriously. We are committed to working closely with Miss Scally from the special events team and Miss Castelino from the parks department to address any concerns and ensure that all necessary measures are in place to promote public safety during our event.

We kindly request that you reconsider your objection in light of the clarifications provided.
