

Register of Members' disclosable pecuniary interests

Under the Localism Act 2011 and the Code of Conduct as an elected Member or voting co-opted member of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (the Council), I give notice that I have the following disclosable pecuniary interests and other registered interests. Please note that the 'owner' of this form is the Monitoring Officer and/or relevant Council officers.

2. SPONSORSHIP *

Any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from the Council) made or provided within the last 12 months in respect of any expenses incurred by you in carrying out duties as a member, or towards your election expenses. This includes any payment or financial benefit from a trade union within the meaning of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act. 1992

3. CONTRACTS *

Any contract which is made between you or the relevant person (or a body in which you or the relevant person has a beneficial interest) and the Council —

- (a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and*
(b) which has not been fully discharged.

4. LAND *

Any beneficial interest you or the relevant person have in land within the area of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.

5. LICENCES *

11. GUIDANCE NOTES TO MEMBERS

1. Definitions

These descriptions of interests are subject to the following definitions;

"relevant person" means:

- Your spouse or civil partner*
- A person with whom you are living as husband or wife*
- A person with whom you are living as husband or wife as if they were your civil partner.*

"body in which you or the relevant person has a beneficial interest" means a firm in which you or the relevant person is a partner or a body corporate of which you or the relevant person is a director, or in the securities of which you or the relevant person has a beneficial interest;

"director" includes a member of the committee of management of an industrial and provident society;

"land" excludes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not carry with it a right for the relevant person (alone or jointly with another) to occupy the land or to receive income;

"securities" means shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited with a building society.

2. Sensitive Interests

Where you consider that information relating to any of your interests is a 'Sensitive Interest' you need not include that interest on this form provided you have consulted with the Monitoring Officer who agrees that it need not be included. A 'Sensitive Interest' is an interest which could create or is likely to create a serious risk that you or a person connected with you may be subjected to violence or intimidation.

Where the interest is no longer a 'Sensitive Interest' you must notify the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of that change.

3. *Other Interests*

The other interests to be registered are the following:

- *Unpaid directorships;*
- *Trusteeships or being on the management board of a charity or body directed to a charitable purpose; and*
- *Membership of any organisation, one of whose principal purposes includes the influence of public opinion or policy, and which is likely to seek to affect the policy of the Council or which may have an impact on its services or those it serves.*

You are only required to register those other interests which are your interests and you do not need to register any other interests of your spouse or partner.



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
