Aim 1:

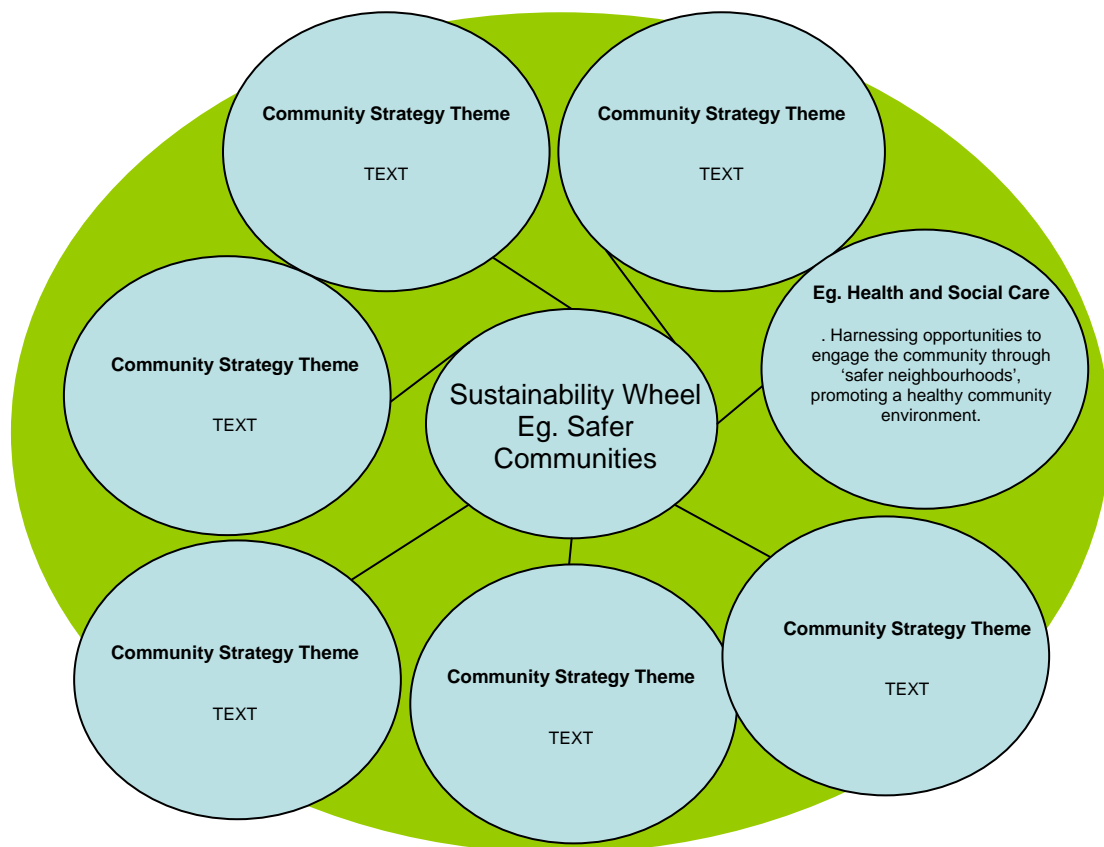
- i. They will be numbered, providing a concise description of what partners will do in order to meet the aim.
- ii. As with the existing strategy, these will be used to determine performance indicators against which to set targets to monitor progress.
- iii. Cross-cutting themes will be denoted with a symbol
- iv. Eg. improving support for vulnerable adults at risk of becoming victims of crime ✱

✱ Symbols will highlight which cross-cutting themes objectives are linking to eg. Health and Well-being.

Fostering vitality/Keeping life local

- A text box will be used to bullet specific policy objectives from the Core Strategy as part of the LDF.
- One will appear in each theme within the strategy drawing out the interface between the LDF and the community strategy relevant to that chapter.
- Eg. Retain local Police Stations that accessible for all.

Each chapter would contain a Sustainability Wheel which would list some sustainability challenges and ambitions underneath each theme of the strategy.



Specific policy objective or projects may also be extracted from the text and main aims and objectives and outlined in a text box which provides more detail.
