1. Introduction

- 1.1 The KCP undertook to review progress in delivering against the aims and objectives of the existing Community Strategy every 18 months. Since a new strategy is being developed, a new monitoring report will be published in April 2008 and officers took the opportunity to provide an update on progress one year on from the last report to the Steering Group.
- 1.2 The report attached at appendix A for information.

2. Report format and content

- 2.1 The Community Strategy monitoring report is presented in two parts; Community Strategy Performance Indicators and Community Strategy Improvement Projects. Community Strategy Performance Indicators show activity where a specific target for progress was designated and the report details the target met. The report also allocates a traffic light assessment based on whether the target was met or not, with an additional brief commentary.
- 2.2 Community Strategy Improvement Projects show activity in a similar way to the LAA 6 month review reports, assessing performance in terms of progress, problems and confidence and allocating an appropriate traffic light. These also include a brief commentary.
