1. Background

1.1 On 28 January 2004, the KCP agreed a programme for NRF in Years 4 and 5 (2004/05 and 2005/06). The KCP made some further approvals at its meeting on 7 July 2004.

- 2.1 The attached spreadsheet shows the allocation for each project for year 4, and expenditure to date as at 3 September 2004.
- 2.2 Some projects, particularly those where new staff are to be recruited, have been slow to start spending. Officers will keep the situation under review, and report back to the KCP if there is a need to take further action to achieve full spend.
- 2.3 Central government announced in the Comprehensive Spending Review that NRF is to continue beyond March 2006, but as yet no detail is available on which geographical areas will be given an allocation.
