### **1. Introduction**

- 1.1 The current Community Strategy was published in November 2005 and a subsequent monitoring plan was published in March 2006. The monitoring plan detailed particular activity and projects that seek to meet the aims and objectives within the Community Strategy. The KCP undertook to review progress in delivering against these aims and objectives and the report attached at appendix A details progress against the Community Strategy monitoring plan.

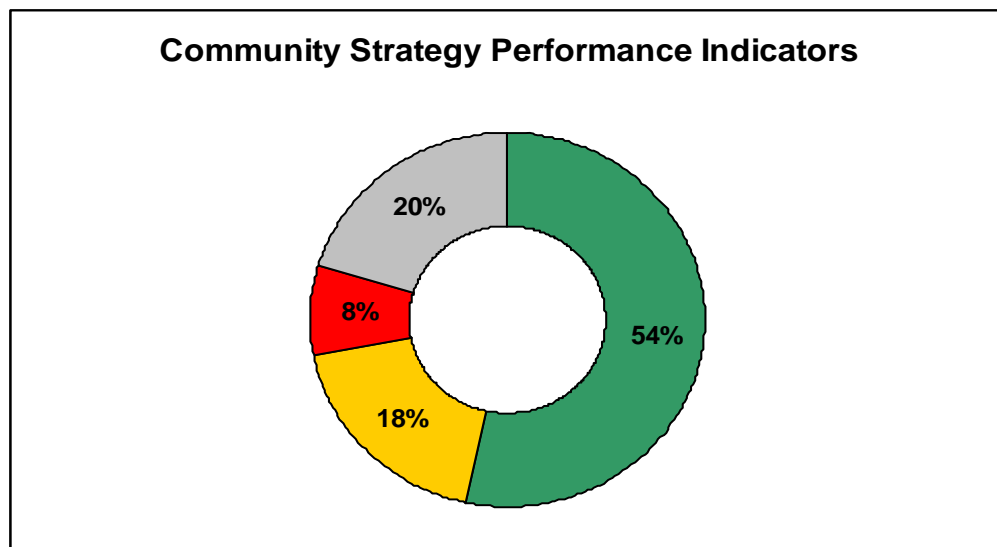
### **2. Report format and content**

- 2.1 The Community Strategy monitoring report, at appendix A, is presented in two parts; Community Strategy Performance Indicators and Community Strategy Improvement Projects. Community Strategy Performance Indicators show activity where a specific target for progress was designated and the report details the target met. The report also allocates a traffic light assessment based on whether the target was met or not, with an additional brief commentary.
- 2.2 Community Strategy Improvement Projects show activity in a similar way to the LAA 6 month review reports, assessing performance in terms of progress, problems and confidence and allocating an appropriate traffic light. These also include a brief commentary.

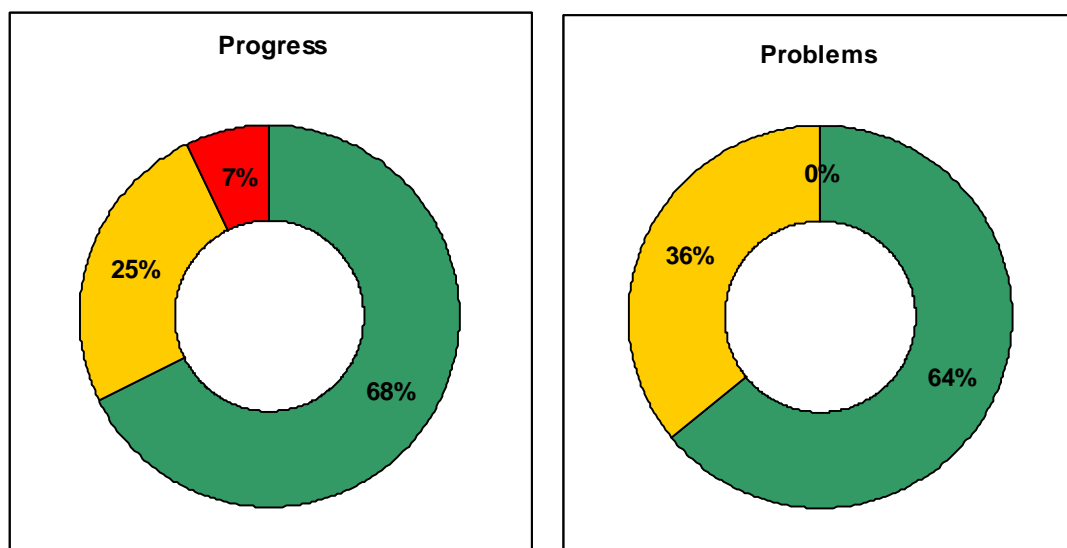
### 3. Performance summary

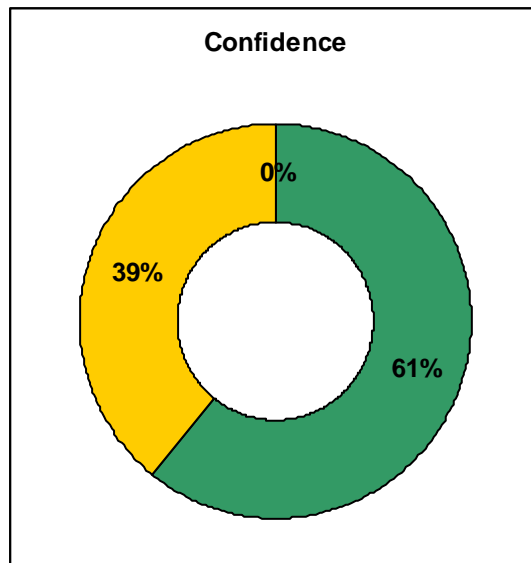
3.1 Performance across Community Strategy Performance Indicators is as follows:
