COMMUNITY STRATEGY MID-TERM REVIEW

This paper invites the Steering Group to discuss and approve the proposed updates for publication as part of the Community Strategy mid-term review.

FOR APPROVAL

1. Background

- 1.1 The Steering Group will recall agreeing to undertake a mid-term review of the existing Community Strategy. The detailed work was delegated to the Community Strategy sub group. The aim of the review is to highlight gaps in the aims and objectives within the existing strategy, and to publish a short document with updated information in November 2007. The review is not intended to focus on new long term objectives, but to highlight new policy priorities and specific work undertaken since publication of the existing Community Strategy. The review is intended to inform development of the 3rd Community Strategy, due for publication in November 2008.

2. The mid-term review process

- 2.1 The Steering Group agreed that the process for undertaking the mid-term review would consist of inviting comments and suggestions from a wide range of colleagues, partners and stakeholders. Suggestions should refer to new or current activity which has a partnership focus and is not already been picked up in the existing strategy.
- 2.2 Comments and suggestions have been put forward by the Community Strategy sub group, agreed by the KCP Steering Group and then further comments and suggestions have been sought from the Health and Well-Being partnership, the PCT Trust Management Team, the Voluntary Organisations Forum, the Family and Children's Strategic Partnership, RBKC Management Board, Learning, Work and Business theme group, the Community Safety Programme Board and a wider range of colleagues across partner organisations.

- 2.3 Officers have worked on the detail of any suggestions put forward and a draft of the proposed final document to be published is attached at Annex A, for comment and approval. The sub-group have approved the attached draft subject to some minor wording amendments to be put forward by relevant officers.

3. Conclusion

- 3.1 The Steering Group is invited to comment on and approve the proposed draft document to be published as part of the mid-term review of the Community Strategy.
