The KCP Steering Group is asked to endorse the final version of the Compact.

FOR APPROVAL

1. Compact

- 1.1 The Compact is an agreement on working relations between the Council and the Voluntary and Community sectors locally. Previously, it existed of four separate documents including codes of practice covering working with BME organisations, consultation, funding and procurement and volunteering.
- 1.2 The Royal Borough was one of the first local authorities to start the process of agreeing these working principles. In order to make best use of the work we have accomplished, these existing documents are now being amalgamated into one Compact and the Compact Implementation Group (CIG) wish to have the endorsement of the Kensington and Chelsea Partnership for the final document.
- 1.3 CIG has membership from the Council, the PCT and the Voluntary sector. Following the KCPs endorsement of the Compact, CIG intend to work with partners to explain how the Compact can be used to help organisations and services work more effectively with Voluntary and Community groups.
