# Meeting of the Shadow LSP Steering Group 25th September 2001

### **Community Strategy Consultation**

### 1. Background

This report details the planned consultation for the Community Strategy.

This consultation has been planned and co-ordinated together with the Social Councils, who will be the recipients of the Community Empowerment Fund and contributing to the costs, and the Primary Care Group and Health Authority.

The Office of Public Management (OPM) has been jointly commissioned by ourselves and the Social Councils to work with us on this process.

#### 2. Process

Details of the consultation plans are attached as appendix A.

A series of small events and meetings targeted at specific groups, areas, interests etc. will be held during September. OPM are working with us to develop a consistent framework for use in these events to ensure that information gathered can be analysed consistently.

OPM have conducted training sessions for all facilitators. These aimed to develop the skills of some of the smaller community groups to engage in this consultation by training their own members to run sessions. This will help meet the requirement of spending CEF money to build community capacity/networks etc.

These smaller events will lead to the October Borough Conference events described below.
