# What is City Living Local Life?

It's a new initiative where local people like you, other community members and your Councillors identify local issues that matter and find practical ways to make your area a better place to live. The programme gives small amounts of money and lots of practical support to the best ideas.

This programme is your chance to make a difference to your street, your estate, your neighbourhood – your local life.

## How does City Living Local Life work?

The Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea is divided into 18 'wards'. Each ward has on average 10,000 people who elect three Councillors to represent them. Councillors are leading City Living Local Life activities by working together with local people and community groups in their ward.

The aim of City Living Local Life is to understand the most important local issues and opportunities and find practical solutions to address them.

Councillors work with all those interested to develop a range of projects - from trying out new schemes to building on projects that have already worked well.

Each ward that takes part in the initiative has a budget of £20,000 per year to help make projects a reality. This money isn't intended to meet the full costs of the project, but it's there to help get projects going or help secure funding from other sources.

### This sounds like a good idea. How can I get involved?

There are a whole range of things you can do to get involved in City Living Local Life, from sharing your project idea to giving an hour or two of your time to support a local event. Let us know what you're interested in on the 'Get Involved' form at the end.

### Frequently asked questions

#### How can I find out who my local Councillors are?

Each ward has three local representatives or Councillors. You can find out who represents you by visiting www.rbkc.gov.uk/councillors or by calling 020 7361 3000.

#### I have an idea for a project. Who should I contact?

To make City Living Local Life a success we need people like you to help generate ideas that will work. You can tell us your idea by completing the form on this leaflet, or by telling your local Councillor directly.

#### Is my ward included?

It is hoped all wards will be part of City Living Local Life by Summer 2012. Each ward will be doing very different things so contact us to find out more.

#### Are there things that the money can't be spent on?

A project can be supported so long as: it meets an identified need and is based on consultation with local people; it isn't at odds with council policies and practices; and it is consistent with rules on spending public money.

#### How can I find out if this initiative is a success?

Information will be available through an annual report and public event; reports at Council meetings; and regular information on budget spend and projects on www.citylivinglocallife.org and in the Royal Borough newspaper. We also encourage you to contact us to find out more.
