What happens to your waste and recycling Collected waste is taken to Western Riverside where recycling material is sorted by a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) and general waste is loaded and transported on barges to an Energy from Waste plant.

Updated Duty of Care from April 2013 (SIC codes) A new version of the Duty of Care was introduced in April 2013 to all commercial waste customers. Businesses have an obligation to prevent waste and to apply the waste hierarchy when transferring waste, and to declare that they have done so as required by Regulation 12 of the Waste (England and Wales) Regulations 2011.

Check the [Waste Hierarchy Guidance](#) [6] for more information on how to prevent waste and what you can recycle.

The updated Duty of Care also includes an area for you to insert your Standard Industry Classification (SIC) code, identifying which sector the waste is coming from.
