**Amendment to Motion (ii) – Holiday Inn, Cromwell Road**

To amend the Motion as follows:

*~~"This Council calls on the Mayor to listen to the overwhelming view among West London residents about the redevelopment of the Holiday Inn on the Cromwell Road that the proposals are too tall, too dense and inappropriate, as reflected in the decision by the RBKC Planning Committee on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2018 to refuse planning permission notes with grave concern the Mayor of London's decision last Friday to overrule the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea's Planning Committee in relation to the Holiday Inn on Cromwell Road. This Council also notes the manner in which the decision was issued, including the lack of consultation by the Mayor in completing the section 106 agreement. We call on the Executive via the Lead Member and the Leadership Team to urgently explore Judicial Review - to explore all legal options available to the Council to challenge the decision with view to quash the decision."~~*

**Amendment to Motion (iii) – Air Quality Improvement**

After the final sentence add the following paragraphs:

*"The Council will consult with residents its intention to implement the following initiatives: Participate in the 22<sup>nd</sup> September Car-Free Day, closing our most polluted roads and through-Borough routes to all but public transport, emergency and essential vehicles, and make all shopping streets car-free.*

*In the longer term, the Council will, for example, consider reducing road space and widening pavements on busy roads, increasing the number of pedestrian areas, allowing more bus and cycle lanes on request, strictly enforce traffic laws to prevent illegal parking/pavement parking and loading-unloading obstructions. It will carry out roadside vehicle emission tests and redouble efforts to encourage local jobs for local people that will reduce journeys."*
