Questions to Lead Members

Cllr. Wade

'What actions has the Deputy Lead Member taken to enhance the Environmental Health team dealing with housing complaints to enable the Council to be able to respond swiftly, and effectively to resident complaints about mould and poor housing conditions across tenure in the light of the tragic death of Awaab Ishak.'

Cllr. Graham

'To ask the Lead Member for Finance to comment on the Mayor of London's planned 10 per cent tax hike and how the Council is working hard to keep taxes low, particularly given neighbouring Hammersmith and Fulham is raising council tax by 3% in a cost of living crisis.'

Cllr. Simmons

'In view of the last 40 years of neglect of Silchester Estate by RBKC, and the threat of regeneration inflicted upon residents, will the Lead Member a) please meet with the Westway Leaseholders Group, and b) apply a Discretionary Reduction or Cap on the costs to leaseholders of the proposed 46-million-pound Major Works to these buildings? It is not acceptable or reasonable in these or any circumstances for this Council to impose either a bill or a potentially life-long debt of one hundred thousand pounds or more each upon these leaseholders.'
