SUPPLEMENTARY REPORT OF THE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE 10 OCTOBER 2006

1. The Administration Committee on 10 October approved the recommendations set out in the report circulated to the Council as item 7(ii), with one amendment.

KEY DECISION DEFINITION

2. To recommend the amendment of paragraph 5 of the notes on page 2 to state:
 5. *In any case of uncertainty, the matter in question shall be treated as a key decision. Furthermore the Leader or any Cabinet Member can give notice that they wish themselves to take any executive-side decision within their portfolio that would otherwise fall within an officer's delegated authority (i.e. recall a specific delegated matter) subject to the usual requirements around advance publicity on the Forward Plan.*
3. The Council is **recommended to approve** the recommendations in the Administration Committee report at paragraphs 1.12 (as amended above) and 2.2.
