- to undertake works to improve the environment beneath all the Hammersmith and City Railway bridges in North Kensington;
- to increase the supply of affordable housing and in particular social rented housing;
- to maintain some commercial retail rents at levels affordable to independent local retailers; and
- to delete the acquisition of the Brompton Cemetery.”
