REPORT BY THE LEADER OF THE COUNCIL**

Article 7.09(f) of the Constitution allows for key decisions to be taken without giving the prescribed notice provided that the prior agreement of the relevant OSC Chairman is obtained. The Leader of the Council is required to report quarterly to the Council on how often the urgency procedure is used and to give details in each case. The urgent decisions taken during the last quarter since January are set out in the table below.
