

# **Colville Community Forum**

The aim of the Colville Community Forum is to improve the quality of life for local people in the Colville Ward of the Royal Borough of Kensington & Chelsea.

The purposes of the charity are:

1. To provide a voice for the local community.
2. To influence and improve local services.
3. To identify opportunities to tackle the unmet needs of local residents.
4. To strengthen partnerships between the local community and service providers (i.e. the Council, Housing Associations etc.).

## **Queen's Park Community Council**

Queen's Park Community Council is the only community (or parish or town) council in London, covering the same area as Queen's Park ward in Westminster.

It was set up in 2014, following a local campaign, and the second cohort of councillors was elected in May 2018.

The community council receives most of its income from a precept – which is an extra amount of Westminster council tax added to local bills. For 2018-2019, this is £46.38 for the average Band D household per year – or 89p a week.

The council funds a variety of local projects and initiatives and has two part-time officers: a chief officer and a community officer.
