Article 7.10(f) of the Constitution allows for key decisions to be taken without giving the prescribed notice provided that the prior agreement of the relevant Scrutiny Committee Chairman is obtained. The Leader of the Council is required to report quarterly to the Council on how often the urgency procedure is used and to give details in each case. Members of the Council are asked to note that no urgent key decisions have been taken since 22 June.
