

**THE ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA****COUNCIL – 24 JANUARY 2007****REVIEW OF ACCESS TO SERVICES FOR DISABLED PEOPLE****REPORT BY COUNCILLOR BUCKMASTER**

1. In September 2005, the Adult Care, Health and Environmental Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee (ACEHH OSC) set up a subgroup to examine how well disabled people are able to access services, including those specialist services aimed at disabled people and those provided to the general public in the Royal Borough.
2. The successor Committee to the ACEHH OSC, the Housing, Environmental Health and Adult Social Care OSC received and approved the recommendations of the Subgroup at its meeting on 22 November 2006 and referred the report to the Cabinet for a response. The report was formally presented to Cabinet on 15 January 2007 and a detailed Cabinet response is expected in February.
3. The Cabinet's response to all the recommendations of the Review, and any subsequent action plans, will be monitored by the Housing, Environmental Health and Adult Social Care OSC.
