REPORT BY THE LEADER OF THE COUNCIL**

Article 7.09(f) of the Constitution allows for key decisions to be taken without giving the prescribed notice provided that the prior agreement of the relevant Scrutiny Committee Chairman is obtained. The Leader of the Council is required to report quarterly to the Council on how often the urgency procedure is used and to give details in each case. The urgent decisions taken during the last quarter since October are set out in the table below. Members of the Council are asked to note these decisions; further details can be made available on request.

There have been no urgent key decisions taken since the last report to Council on 21 April.
