Buzzing Bumblebees – store honey in pots in their nests

📍 Fountain, Ice House Flower Beds



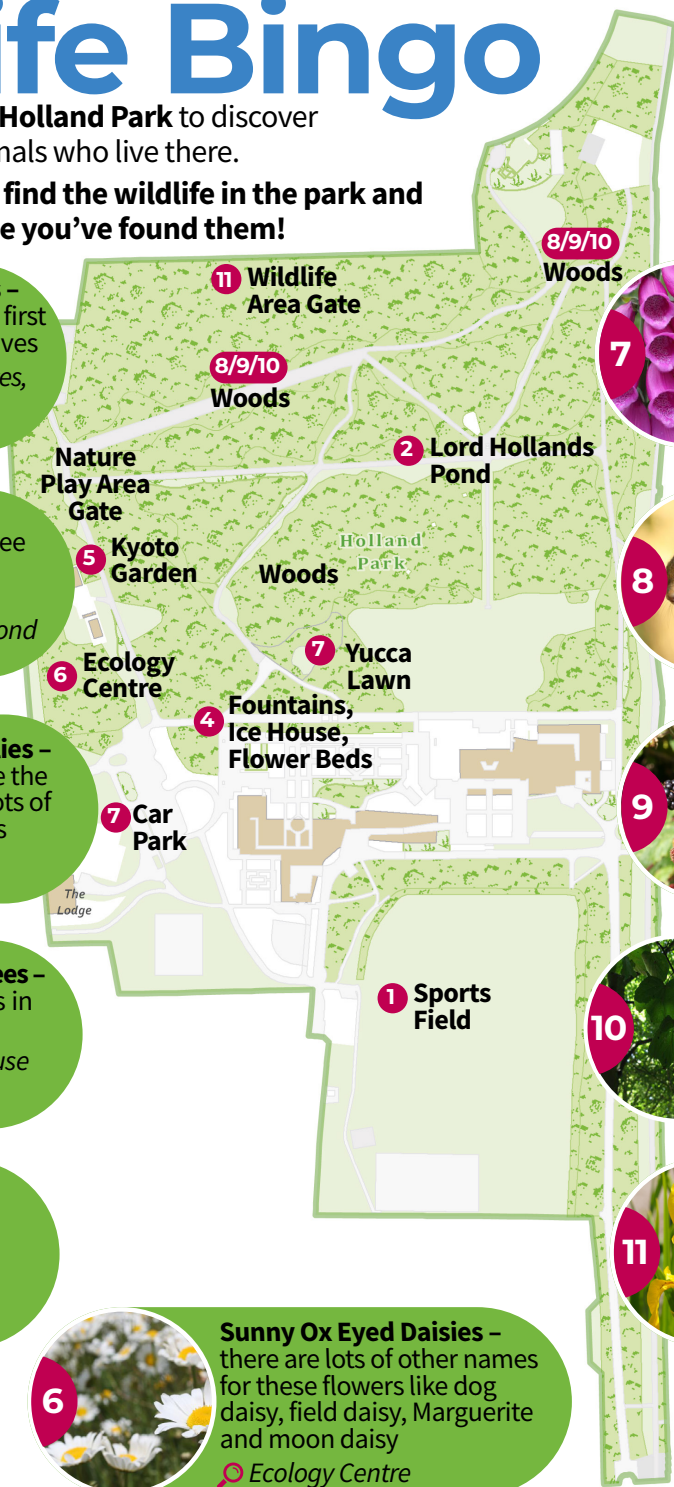
Darting Dragonflies – an adult catches and eats its prey whilst flying around
