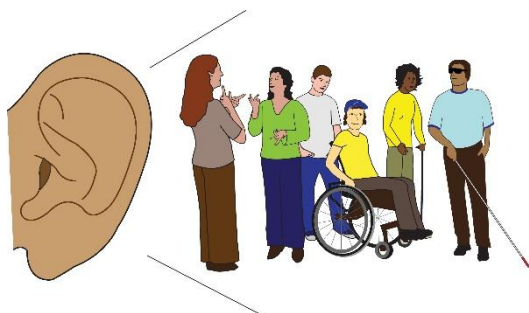


# Our promise to involve you in our work

We will:

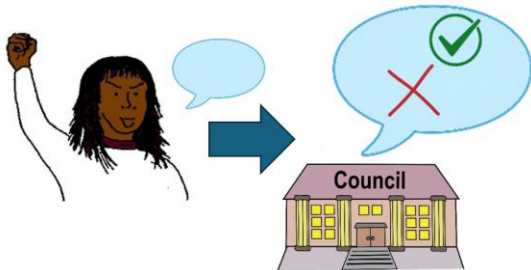
- share problems

- **Be fair and reliable**

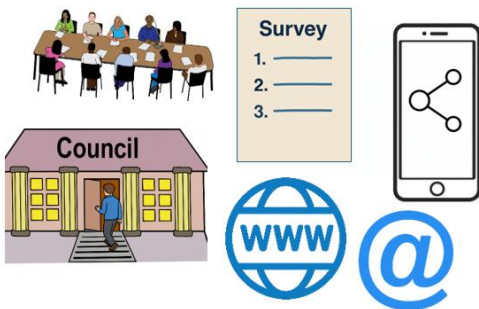
- Everyone who lives, works or studies here can have their say.

You will have your say before we make decisions.

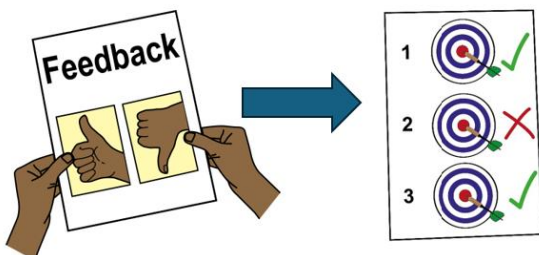


- **Different ways to get involved –**  
in-person meetings, surveys, drop-ins, online and on social media.



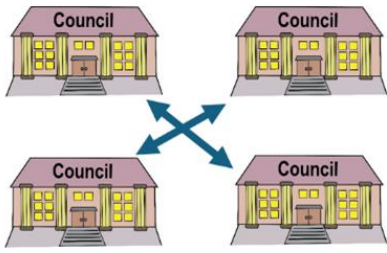
- **Being clear**

We will work with other Council teams so you won't have to repeat yourself.

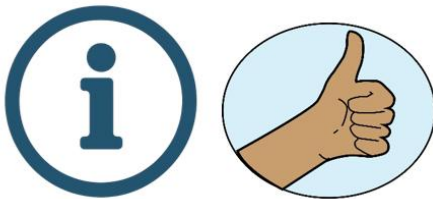
We will reward you for your time.

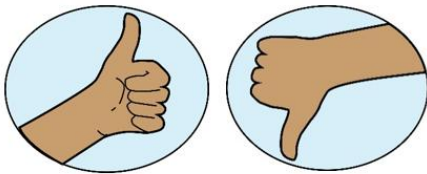

- **Join “scrutiny reviews”**

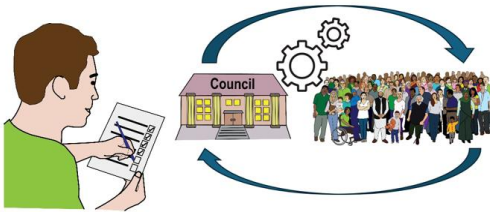
- A scrutiny review makes sure decision-makers or services are working properly.



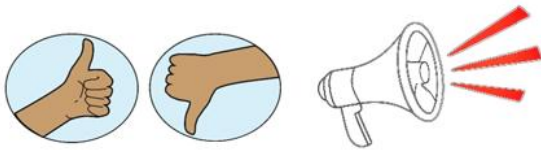
