

22. The back block of flats at Trafalgar Gardens will have no access for a fire-engine on the plans as they stand. This must be addressed urgently for the safety of the residents in the event of a fire. There is no access for fire engines to these flats except through Hethrop site.
23. Can fire engines and ambulances get to the vent, (open area) if needed for the underground in the south east corner if they have to. At the moment there is no access for them to do so on the plans. The road on the other side is 25 ft below the railway line. But on site at the moment they can get to this area as it is level with the ground.
24. Will any water be recycled, eg underground pumps, roof water?
25. Will there be any solar panels etc on the roofs.?
26. If this does go through, we will be looking to the council to drop the council tax substantially in the areas affected by the lorries and the building works for the duration of the development.

We hope these observations are helpful, and that the Council will refuse permission for this development, if not make the development smaller, and retain the buildings that are there at the moment. Many have been used in the past as a nursing home.
