I refer to your letter received on 16 August 2016 consulting the Mayor of London on the above planning application, which is referable under Categories 1B of the Schedule to the Order 2008.

The application proposes amendments to condition 2 (compliance with approved drawings) of the original planning application 15/04338 to enable the demolition of Friese Green House, alterations to the King's Road elevation, additional basement excavation and provision of additional photovoltaic panels.

I have assessed the details of the application and, given the scale and nature of the proposals, I have concluded that the amendments do not give rise to any new strategic planning issues.

Therefore, under article 5(2) of the above Order the Mayor of London does not need to be consulted further on this application. Your Council may, therefore, proceed to determine the application without further reference to the GLA.
