Hi Peter,

Thank you for getting in touch.

Yes, I saw that a Written Scheme of Investigation (WSI) had been submitted with the application and mentioned within my original letter (on the last page) that *"Having considered the submitted document I confirm it is in compliance with the first part of our recommended archaeological condition and relevant standards and guidance."*

I could reword my recommended condition so that it refers to the submitted and approved WSI, however this can cause problems if for some reason the scope of the evaluation needs to change. As far as I understand it, if this occurred you would have to apply for a variation to the condition.

I would therefore recommend sticking to the original condition, and so long as Lara is in agreement, once consent has been granted, the evaluation can commence in accordance with the WSI.

I hope that this makes sense but please let me know if you have any questions.
