Twenty-eight days before any abnormal use (such as earthmoving equipment for removal of spoil, excavation equipment etc) of highways serving the site commences, the Applicant should submit to the Director of Transportation and Highways a management plan with regard to the routing of construction vehicles and access arrangements to the site. The plan should include the estimated number of vehicles per day/week, details of the holding area, and the call up procedure. Before any abnormal use of the highway can commence this management plan must be approved by the Director of Transportation and Highways in writing.
