Dear Mr. Haire

I put up a further copy of each notice on the tree cage on the pavement at the street corner on Monday.

Representations received after 27/7 will not be disregarded, but should be received as soon as possible so that they can be taken into account during the application process. The target date for determination of the applications is 20/8 and they are unlikely to be determined much before then. The Site Notice only needs to be displayed for a week to comply with the Act. I do not consider it necessary to "formally" extend the consultation period since in practice I will not turn away representations received later.

I am receiving a number of representations direct to my own email address. The correct procedure is to send a letter as stated on the Site Notice and the notification letters, or to send an email to the general planning mailbox which is planning@rbkc.gov.uk. This avoids the danger of representations being missed because they are going to the wrong place, and allows our Support team to enter them in the computer system and send out an acknowledgement letter. If you are aware of whoever is suggesting that people email me direct, I'd be grateful if you would let them know the correct procedure!
