

PLANNING APPLICATION PUBLIC COMMENT

Application number: PP/17/01413
Site Address: Queen Ann's Orangery, Palace Green, LONDON, W8 4PZ
Proposal: Demolition of structures to rear of The Orangery, construction of extension comprising basement and single storey above ground. Alterations, including provision of two internal links to landscaping south of The Orangery lawn, including new gardener's store. Provision of temporary marquee during period of construction. Associated works and landscaping.

Comment received: This is a historic building and should not be disturbed. There can be no justification for a double basement. The Orangery is a central feature of the park which should be maintained as a peaceful leisure facility for Londoners. ANY traffic management plan will seriously disrupt the park, its wild life, and people using the park for peace and leisure. Augmenting the capacity of the Orangery for entertainment purposes will cause a nuisance to park users and set a precedent for other buildings.

Whatever next?

The consultation is bogus and the planning department seems to have been bedazzled by courtiers when giving pre application advice.
