Comment received: Subject: 132B Fulham Road

I strongly object to the present application for the demolition of the present property and it being replaced by a modern house with a large basement network.

Although the existing property was not built at the same time as its neighbours, and may be 'modern' by comparison, it is in keeping in style and brick colour, It is pleasing in appearance and does not seem out of keeping with its loftier neighbours. It is charming and sits comfortably with its neighbours.

To put between these 19th century properties in Cranley Gardens and Fulham Road a modern structure is unacceptable in design and style and will be an eye-sore to the location.

Added to which, the work involves many long months or years with lorries and skips entering and exiting the site onto Fulham Road and Cranley Gardens, both of which are already highly congested. There are bus-stops adjacent and opposite the property and these no doubt will be out of service for the whole period which will not be convenient for local residents, certainly myself and other elderly people.

The noise and dirt which will ensue during these works will be harsh and on-going and to what end? The erection of a totally modern property with deep basement.

What amazes me is that Ken & Chelsea would even consider such an application.
