Proposal: Demolition of dwelling house and erection of a two storey 2-bedroom detached house with subterranean development

Comment received: Here we go again. A incongruous design, completely unnecessary replacing a sympathetic existing residence amongst Grade II listed properties within a conservation area.

Residents, who tend their properties with the minimum of invasion to their neighbours quality of life, have to put up with month after month of noise and congestion from continuous delivery of building materials by HGV on busy streets that carry emergency traffic.

This proposed demolition and rebuild, including a huge basement that is worryingly close to the foundations of Georgian properties of 130-132 Fulham Rd, and extends under a Victorian perimeter wall of 35-37 Cranley Gardens, which is only one meter from a seven story building, will cause mayhem to traffic at one of the areas busiest junctions.

There is no reason for such an inessential, ugly building to be built in this location. I strongly object to this planning proposal and trust the council will this time, take into account the collective disapproval of neighbours to this unwanted development.
