Proposal: Demolition of dwelling house and erection of a two storey 2-bedroom detached house with subterranean development

**Comment received:** I attach some photos of the proposed perforated Corten sheet cladding showing the extent to which the material will allow sunlight and day lighting to penetrate the interiors and allow views of adjoining properties from within. This will also result in a bizarre lighting effect in the evening/night time visible to properties outside.

I am surprised that use of this material could possibly be sympathetic to the surrounding buildings in what is a Conservation area.

I would be most grateful if you could throw out the 132b Fulham Road planning application, and at the very least prevent the use of this Corten material which is completely at odds with the beautiful brick buildings in this Conservation area.
