

PLANNING APPLICATION PUBLIC COMMENT

Application number: PP/18/05313
Site Address: Heythrop College, 23-24 Kensington Square, LONDON, W8 5HH
Proposal: Reinstatement of three townhouses (Class C3), (part of 23 and 24 Kensington Square); refurbishment of college building (part of 23 Kensington Square) and use as an extra care facility (Class C2). Demolition of all other buildings on site. Erection of deck over adjacent London Underground line and construction of 5 buildings (ranging between 1 and 8 storeys in height) for use as an extra care facility including units, communal facilities and services areas, community hall and on-site affordable housing and associated access parking, servicing and landscaping. (MAJOR DEVELOPMENT)

Comment received: The main problem is the huge scale of the project, a vast housing estate benefitting only the very rich. An enormous construction site requiring an incredible amount construction traffic going within a few feet of my little one bedroom house for 5 years! It has been calculated that at its height lorries will pass my house and all the other poor residents along the route every 3-4 minutes. This is completely unbearable and something no one could possibly endure. The proposed route could hardly be less suitable, it is far too narrow and St Albans Grove is even designated a Cycling Quietway! Why should all the local residents suffer such terrible disruption for a project that will bring them very little public benefit? The noise, the potential damage, the risk to safety (St. Thomas's School next door to me has a constant stream of young children walking along the very narrow pavement) are reason enough to oppose this development. A much smaller development more in keeping with the nature and constraints of the site and a more direct and safer access route possibly via Kensington Square, not passing so many residential homes and schools, is the only possible solution. I strongly oppose this planning application.
