

PLANNING APPLICATION PUBLIC COMMENT

Application number: PP/18/05313
Site Address: Heythrop College, 23-24 Kensington Square, LONDON, W8 5HH
Proposal: Reinstatement of three townhouses (Class C3), (part of 23 and 24 Kensington Square); refurbishment of college building (part of 23 Kensington Square) and use as an extra care facility (Class C2). Demolition of all other buildings on site. Erection of deck over adjacent London Underground line and construction of 5 buildings (ranging between 1 and 8 storeys in height) for use as an extra care facility including units, communal facilities and services areas, community hall and on-site affordable housing and associated access parking, servicing and landscaping. (MAJOR DEVELOPMENT)

Comment received: Approving this application would be in clear contravention of the Council's policy that "social and community uses" should be protected and retained, to protect low-value uses from high-value uses, such as residential.

This proposal is for high value residential units overtly aimed at the high end of the market. The on-site "extra-care" provided does not make this the equivalent of a care-home, and should not be used to avoid the obligations of developing a designated "social and community use" site, which include building affordable housing.

The proposed development has no value to the majority community of the Borough, and the Council must recognise this. Even if it somehow manages to comply with the letter of the law on this, it most certainly is nowhere near the spirit of it.

The Council must not allow further expansion of the already large stock of very high value properties, most of which are unoccupied and drain our communities of life as well as squandering valuable space.

The proposed development would have its main entrance via a network of tiny streets, which are completely unsuitable for access other than in the smallest volumes. The construction traffic involved in the actual build would pose a very serious problem indeed.
