I write further to my letter 31 October 2018 setting out my client's objection to the Heythrop College Applications.

I would be grateful for an update on the current position in respect of the Applications and confirmation that the Council will be asking the applicant to respond to the points raised in our client's objection. In particular, the request for copies of the existing traffic surveys undertaken by the applicant in 2017 to be made available and for a road safety audit of South End to be undertaken. Please would you confirm that the Council will not seek to determine the Applications (unless officers are minded to recommend refusal) until this information has been provided and made available for further public consultation.

Our client maintains that the proposals will result in an unacceptable increase in traffic levels through South End and that given the scale and nature of the proposed development alternative access arrangements from the other side of the railway line should be fully explored by the applicant. Please would you confirm that the Council has requested the applicant to review its proposals and to fully and properly consider alternative vehicular access arrangements, in the absence of which the application should be withdrawn or refused.
