Animal Simulations

Animals are beautiful things to see, especially in the wild. But what if I told you, you could have **life sized** wild animals in your home right now? Follow the steps to create virtual reality animals which you can photograph and learn about!

Find a place you would like to simulate your animal. It needs to be big enough for the real animal to fit, so it could be your kitchen table or perhaps in your garden.

Step One

Open your web browser on your phone and search for the animal you want. They don't have every animal, so see below for a list of the ones you can find!

Step Two

Scroll down and find the 'View in 3D' button as shown opposite. Click this and away you go! Keep your camera still, pointing where you want the animal to appear. Take some photos!

Step Three

Some questions to consider: Would your animal survive in your house? Do you think you would be safe if it were real? Which of the animals on the list are found in the UK naturally?
