NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea has confirmed a Direction under Article 4(1) of The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 as amended ('GPDO').

The Direction was made on 12 September 2017 and confirmed on 22 February 2019 and applies to:-

the entire area of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.

The Direction applies to the development described in the following class of the GPDO:-

Class O, Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the said Order insofar as it relates to the change of use of a building and any land within its curtilage from a use falling within *Class B1(a)* (offices) to a use falling within *Class C3* (dwellinghouses).

The effect of the Direction is that the permission granted by Article 3 of the GPDO shall not apply to such development and such development shall not be carried out within that area unless planning permission is granted by the Council.
