

Grenfell Community Support Programme

A new programme of Grenfell support has just launched for the immediate community near Grenfell Tower.

The support is specifically for residents who live within 500m of the Tower, or moved out since the tragedy.

The support includes:

- A **£350 wellbeing grant** for households living in the area at the time of the tragedy
- A **free Kensington Leisure Centre membership**
- Support from the **Grenfell Community Advocacy team** with **housing, health and other issues**
