

DESIGN 1 - LOTS ROAD OPEN SPACE (







KEY

- 1. Corolle Planters: Carbon steel planters with canopy of mesh fiberglass tubes to allow for climbing plants. Structures to aid urban cooling, filter air pollutants and attract pollinators.
- 2. Raised planters with tree planting.
- 3. Linear orchard: Raised planters with espalier fruit tree planting.
- 4. Raised planter with trellis and climbing plants.
- 5. Raised planter with trellis and climbing plants and hibernacula panels.
- 6. Series of play mounds with low level play equipment, to include accessible and inclusive activities.
- 7. Seating: curved timber benches including: standard benches, loungers and podiums with and without arm and back rests for accessibility.
- 8. Seating: standard benches with and without arm and back rests to maximise accessibility.
- 9. Raised planters with tree planting and seating in quieter part of the park.
- 10. Trompe l'oeil de-marking Thames Tideway Tunnel in playful waterfall mural.
- 11. Picnic Tables.
- 12. Chess Tables.
- 13. Football and basketball courts.
- 14. New gateway and signage at entrance.
- 15. Running track.
- 16. Food & Beverage: space for coffee truck, seating, drinking and fountain.
- 17. Park totem information board, including history of the Site.
- 18. Potential mural or public area on adjoining wall of Chelsea Wharf.
- 19. Potential events such as seasonal outdoor cinema.
- 20. Future access to jetty being explored.
- *All elements are designed to be demountable and moveable, allowing adaptability if the wider community of Cremorne changes it's needs in the future.
- *Play equipment, activities and sport in 'Activities zone' are all flexible and would be developed through consultation with the local community.
